CRLG Asked to Consider Revision to By Laws

Family Membership Proposal

At the December 2018 board meeting, the board discussed amending Article V of the by-laws to include a family membership.

As it now stands:

First time attendees come to Lace Day free. Subsequent visits require payment. Attendees to Lace Day who come in the afternoon to shop do not pay an entrance fee.

Membership benefits include lower fee for Lace Day; a newsletter and notices; a membership directory.

To make a Family Membership available:

The Family Membership would be for two or more parties living at the same residence.

Only one email address will be used for communication, (newsletter, notices, directory)

although all parties in a household would be recognized as members.

All parties would use the lower member rate to attend Lace Day.

The board approved this amendment as worded. It now seeks approval from the membership to amend Article V of the by-laws to include a family membership category.

CRLG Looking for Volunteer Board Members

We extend our gratitude to all the CRLG Board members for their time and dedication. VP Elaine Chock will not be continuing on the CRLG Board.
